### **CALL FOR APPLICATIONS**

Application deadline: Thursday, December 31, 2009

An agreement between the Kuwait Foundation for the Advancement of Sciences and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology provides Kuwaiti professionals such as professors, researchers and engineers the opportunity to apply for this Fellowship Program to MIT at the Kuwait-MIT Center for Natural Resources and the environment. All applicants must hold a minimum of a Masters Degree. It is designed for individuals who wish to do research at MIT. Awards are normally for a twelve-month (12) duration, although shorter periods (three (3) to six (6) months will also be considered). Successful applicants will receive an appropriate stipend based on the length of stay. It is anticipated that the employer will pay the salary of the scholar. The employer must provide an official letter indicating their financial support for the duration of the program.

The KFAS-MIT Committee will convene a special Selection Committee in January 2010 to interview potential candidates. Interviews will take place in Kuwait.
